PRESIDENT'S THOUGHTS







Beat the Heat: Protecting Your Employees from Hot Weather

As the temperatures rise outside during summer months, so do the risks that your employees may be harmed by the dangerous effects of heat. As a business owner, it's your responsibility to help monitor and minimize the risk of heat stress for your workers.

Consider the Heat Index and Temperature

The heat index combines air temperature and humidity to determine how hot it feels outside:

- 80-90°F: Caution needed for prolonged moderate work outdoors.
- 91-103°F: Use extreme caution, reduce outdoor work, take extra breaks, and monitor workers closely.
- 103-124°F: Danger for prolonged exposure. Halt outdoor work (except emergencies) to prevent heat illness.
- **126°F or higher:** Extreme danger, avoid outdoor work. High humidity above 60% affects sweat evaporation, impacting the body's cooling ability¹.


Keeping Your Employees Safe

Business owners should consider monitoring daily heat index readings and adjusting work schedules and demands accordingly to prevent heat illness. <u>Risk management tactics</u> may help, including:

- Additional Workers: Bringing on extra workers for labor-intensive projects to allow for more frequent breaks.
- **Preventative Measures:** Offering regular rest breaks, shade, water, and adjusted schedules to minimize heat-related risks.
- Acclimatization: Allowing new and returning workers to gradually increase exposure time for working in the heat.
- Appropriate Attire: Providing lightweight, breathable clothing or Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for comfort and safety.
- Adjusting Workloads: Considering rescheduling highly labor-intensive tasks to cooler parts of the day if possible.
- **Heat Illness Recognition:** Educating workers on symptoms of heat exhaustion and heat stroke: headache, dizziness, weakness, upset stomach, excessive sweating, elevated body temperature, and red/hot/dry skin.
- **Medical Attention:** Encouraging workers experiencing symptoms to stop work and seek medical help immediately¹.

ILLINOIS PHCC AUXILIARY 2024 Service Project

Each year the Illinois Auxiliary has a service project to benefit others. For 2024 they chose the Guardian Angel Home as their benefactor.

The Guardian Angel Residential Program for Youth serves young boys who have experienced significant abuse, neglect or sexual abuse, and are exhibiting emotional, behavioral or mental health issues that require 24-hour services to be provided in a safe, supportive living environment. Currently, Guardian Angel Home is a 16-bed, all-male, residential treatment facility that is licensed for ages 6 to 12 years of age. The goal is to provide comprehensive intensive treatment services which will allow the youth to return to family, a relative family member, a community foster family home or independent living.

They have a limited amount of funding from the state of Illinois and are dependent upon the care and generosity of donors and supporters. On June 27th, a check from the Illinois PHCC Auxiliary for \$2,000 was presented to the Guardian Home staff to help with their ongoing needs.

The Illinois Auxiliary is able to fund donations such as this with the revenue generated from their Expo Program Book, t-shirt sales, silent auctions, and other fundraisers.



MANDATORY SEXUAL HARASSMENT PREVENTION TRAINING

Public Act 101-0221 (commonly referred to as the Workplace Transparency Act), requires Illinois employers to provide sexual harassment prevention training to their employees on an annual basis, regardless of the size of the company.

Under this law, Illinois employers have until December 31st each year to train employees on sexual harassment **prevention.** The Act provides minimum standards that must be included in the training. To assist your business in complying with this new law, the Illinois Department of Human Rights has posted the following information on its website:

- A FAQ for Sexual Harassment Prevention Training
- Minimum Sexual Harassment Prevention Training Standards for All Employers

Employers must either develop their own sexual harassment prevention training program that equals or exceeds the minimum standards for sexual harassment prevention training outlined in Section 2-109(B) of the Illinois Human Rights Act, or they may use the model training provided by the IDHR. Question

We would like to create a summer dress code, so our employees do not have to wear suits during the hot summer months. Are we allowed to set a dress code and say what is and is not permitted (e.g., no t-shirts with profanity, nudity, etc.)? Also, we want to allow female employees to wear sandals, but require male employees to wear shoes or sneakers. Is this permissible?

NSWER

Employers generally have the right to establish and enforce a dress code policy as a condition of employment. Because federal and state laws generally do not directly govern these policies, employers have a lot of flexibility in creating an appropriate dress code for their environments. Typical dress code policies may include, for example, an organizational philosophy, appropriate attire, prohibited attire and how the policy will be enforced.

Of course, an employer's policy should not violate discrimination laws. For example, a gender-neutral dress code policy may help avoid discrimination claims on the basis of sex. In this regard, a policy should not require all male employees to wear closed-toed shoes in the summer while allowing female employees to wear open-toed sandals. Whether sandals are permitted or not should be applied to everyone or, at least, everyone who is similarly situated. This means that an employer can have dress code distinctions based on, for instance, departments or divisions, but the distinctions would need to apply to everyone within such departments or divisions.

Employers should also keep in mind that they may need to make accommodations due to, for example, an employee's religious beliefs or disability. It may be beneficial for employers to work with local counsel when drafting a dress code policy to ensure it satisfies the employer's objectives and complies with applicable federal, state, and local laws.
