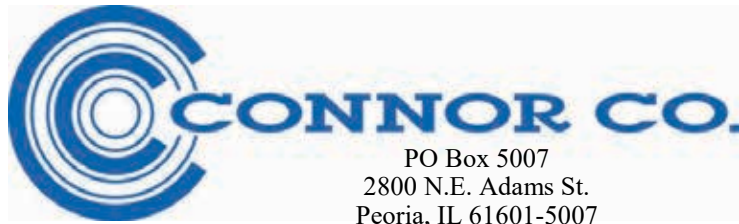

LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Spring Session of the 104th Illinois General Assembly is now past the deadline for bills to be out of committee in their chamber of origin. House bills listed in House Rules or Senate bills listed in Assignments are considered dead for this session unless they have been granted an extension. There are many bills that deal with Energy Conservation, Workforce Development, Employment, Procurement, Lead Service Lines, and Utilities that we are still watching. Below are a few of those bills and their current status.

Plumbing/Piping/Trade Related Bills:

AHB 1612 (K BUCKNER) Creates the Illinois Appliance Standards Act. Directs the Illinois EPA to adopt minimum efficiency standards for covered products. Provides for testing, certification, and labeling of covered products. These standards will apply to commercial and residential faucets, water coolers, water heaters, toilets, urinals, showers, irrigation controllers and more. Re-referred to House Rules.

HB 4272 (M. CRAWFORD) Provides that no person shall sell, attempt to sell, or offer to sell to a consumer in the State a non-externally vented natural gas appliance that is manufactured on or after January 1, 2027 unless a label on the gas appliance bears a specified warning message. Re-referred to House Rules.

HB 4361 (K. STUART) Provides that an individual performing plumbing inspections shall be licensed under the Illinois Plumbing License Law and shall be exempt from the certification requirements of the Warehouse Tornado Preparedness Act. Passed out of Counties & Township Committee and is on 2nd Reading in the House.

HB 4379 (A. BRIEL) Amends the Equitable Restrooms Act to provide that the owner or operator of each State-owned building and the owner or operator of each public building shall ensure that one or more of the public restrooms is designated as an adult changing station, with certain requirements. On 2nd Reading in the House.

HB 4489 (A. STAVA) Amends the Construction Site Temporary Restroom Facility Act to change the short title to the Construction Site Temporary Restroom Facility and Sanitary Conditions for Menstruation and Lactation Act. Repeals a provision which specifies that separate toileting facilities are not required for males and females if individual portable toilet facilities are used by an owner of a portable building or building under construction to provide access to a restroom. Other provisions. Re-referred to House Rules.

HB 4760 (T. MAH) Same as HB 4489. On 2nd Reading in the House.

SB 3465 (G. GUZMAN) Same as HB 4489 & 4760. On 3rd Reading in the Senate.

HB 5366 (M. CANTY) Creates the Illinois Appliance Standards Act. Directs the IEPA to adopt minimum efficiency standards for covered products. Provides for testing, certification, and labeling of covered products. On 2nd Reading in the House.

HB 5519 (J. MASON) Amends the Illinois Plumbing License Law. In provisions concerning plumbing contractors, provides that the Department of Public Health shall provide notices to each licensee regarding application for registration on or before July 1 of each year. Referred to House Rules.

SB 2828 (S. BELT) Provides that an individual performing plumbing inspections shall be licensed under the Illinois Plumbing License Law and shall be exempt from the certification requirements of the Warehouse Tornado Preparedness Act. On 3rd Reading in the Senate.

SB 4025 (R. VILLIVALAM) Amends the Environmental Protection Act. Provides that an owner or operator of a community water supply that performs at least 4,000 lead service line replacements per year or exceeds a statutorily prescribed lead service line replacement rate is exempt from a provision that prohibits partial lead service line replacements. Other provisions. On 3rd Reading in the Senate.

SB 4063 (L. ELLMAN) Provides that a municipality shall complete its initial plan review within a designated timeframe and if they fail to do so, then the applicant may retain a qualified third-party plan reviewer. Provides that, if a municipality fails to conduct a required inspection within 2 business days, then the applicant may retain a qualified third-party inspector. The bill does not require inspectors to be licensed plumbers, but requires ICC or IAPMO certification. Referred to Senate Assignments.

CONSTRUCTION/BUSINESS RELATED BILLS:

HB 3762 (E. GONZALEZ, JR.) Creates the Workplace Extreme Temperature Safety Act. Provides that the Director of Labor shall adopt rules to establish excessive heat and excessive cold standards. On 2nd Reading in the House. Amendments are pending.

HB 4076 (J. GORDON-BOOTH) Amends the Paid Leave for All Workers Act. Removes a provision that exempts from the Act any employee working in the construction industry who is covered by a bona fide collective bargaining agreement. Referred to House Rules.

HB 4412 (D. BLAIR-SHERLOCK) Provides that the Capital Development Board may enter into contracts and manage construction projects pursuant to a public-private partnership agreement on behalf of an institution of higher education or a State agency. Re-referred to House Rules.

HB 4751 (J. HOFFMAN) Amends the Prevailing Wage Act to restore certain provisions of the Act to the form in which they existed before Public Act 104-17 took effect. Provides that nothing in the Act prohibits the payment of wages and fringe benefits for work performed under the Act that are paid in accordance with a collective bargaining agreement or understanding between an employer or an employer association and a bona fide labor organization. Effective July 1, 2026. Referred to House Rules.

HB 4800 (D. VELLA) Creates the Local Government Building Permit Act. Provides that the Act only applies to units of local government that require a person to obtain a permit before they may construct a building. Requirements for timelines, building codes, automatic approval, appeals. Re-referred to House Rules.

HB 5454 (D. AVELAR) A housing merchant implied warranty shall mean that: (1) one year from and after the warranty date the home will be free from defects due to a failure to have been constructed in a skillful manner; (2) two years from and after the warranty date the plumbing, electrical, heating, cooling, and ventilation systems will be free from defects due to a failure by the builder to have installed the systems in a skillful manner; and (3) six years from and after the warranty date the home will be free from material defects. Referred to House Rules.

AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP RULES

Scholarships for college or vocational education are awarded by the Illinois Auxiliary for a minimum of \$500.00 up to a maximum of \$2,000.00 each year in June, as funds are available.

1. The applicant must be at least a freshman in college having completed one full semester with at least 8 credit hours of study. Seniors in high school may NOT apply.
2. No person may receive more than one award from the Illinois Auxiliary during his or her academic career. There cannot be more than two awards per family per year. A permanent list of recipients will be kept in the scholarship files.
3. In addition to the completed application form, the applicant must submit the following:
 - A letter from the applicant with personal data, family size, explanation of need for scholarship monies, and career plans. Also include information about participation in high school, college, and community activities as well as work experience. Knowledge of and/or working experiences with plumbing industry may be included, but is not necessary.
 - Three letters of recommendation.
 - One letter must be from a sponsor who is a member in good standing of the Illinois PHCC Auxiliary.
 - The other two letters must be from people who know the applicant personally and can attest to the applicant's character. They may also provide additional pertinent information such as academic performance and involvement in extra-curricular activities. Knowledge of parents does not necessarily qualify them for having knowledge of applicant.
 - Official transcripts—see details on application form.
4. **The deadline for submitting the application is May 22, 2026.**
 - Application must be postmarked no later than this date and include all the information required. If it is incomplete, application materials will be discarded and applicant will not be considered for a scholarship. Applicants may resubmit the following year.

ILLINOIS PHCC PAST PRESIDENT'S CLUB SCHOLARSHIP FUND

1. Name of the Scholarship Fund shall be the "Illinois PHCC Assn. Past President's Club Scholarship Award".
2. Scholarship is established through dues income to Past President's Club.
3. A scholarship shall be awarded to an individual who has been nominated by a member of the Illinois PHCC Past President's Club who has been a member in good standing for the past two years.
4. Applicant must have the following qualifications:

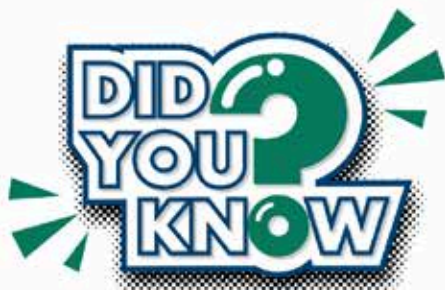

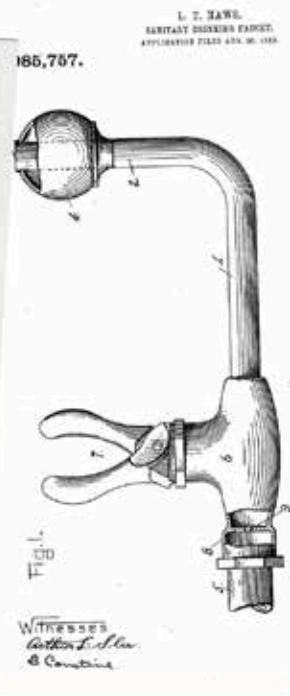
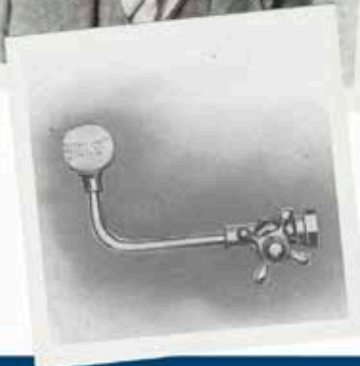
