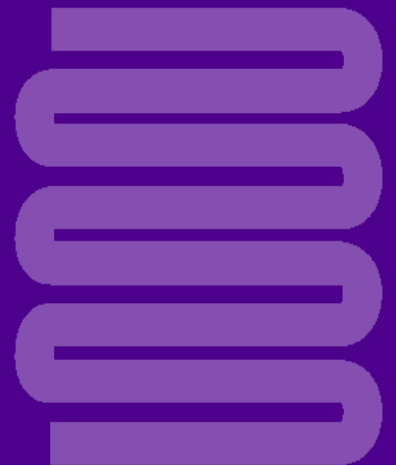

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PLUMBING CONTRACTOR REGISTRATION RENEWAL TIME

All plumbing contractors registered with the Illinois Department of Public Health will receive a renewal form in August. Even though you may be renewing online, you must still email the insurance and bonds.

In the event that the online renewal should become unavailable, follow the instructions on the renewal form. If your renewal forms and payment must be sent by mail, you will still be able to email the insurance and bond documents.

Please make sure you look at all the materials carefully and submit your renewal as soon as possible - DON'T DELAY. Your registration is NOT considered renewed until full payment and your renewal documents (i.e. Surety Bond, Certificate of Insurance) are received. All of these items MUST be received on or before September 30th to avoid late penalty.

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LEGISLATIVE UPDATE

The Spring Session of the 104th Illinois General Assembly adjourned on May 31st. Legislators return to Springfield for 6 days next fall for the Veto Session. Bills that passed both chambers must be sent to the Governor within 30 days. He then has 60 days to take action on them. If he takes no action, they automatically become law.

Plumbing/Piping/Trade Related Bills:

HB 4361 (K. Stuart) Provides that an individual performing plumbing inspections shall be licensed under the Illinois Plumbing License Law and shall be exempt from the certification requirements of the Warehouse Tornado Preparedness Act. Amended to extend the time to obtain certifications, exempts building inspectors conducting inspections prior to January 1, 2026 with 5 years of experience, those accredited through an approved apprenticeship program, and others. Sent to the Governor on June 18th and signed into law on June 26th.

HB 4379 (A. Briel) Amends the Equitable Restrooms Act to provide that the owner or operator of each State-owned building and the owner or operator of each public building shall ensure that one or more of the public restrooms is designated as an adult changing station, with certain requirements. Sent to the Governor on June 26th.

SB 3465 (G. Guzman) Amends the Construction Site Temporary Restroom Facility Act to change the short title to the Construction Site Temporary Restroom Facility and Sanitary Conditions for Menstruation and Lactation Act. Repeals a provision which specifies that separate toileting facilities are not required for males and females if individual portable toilet facilities are used by an owner of a portable building or building under construction to provide access to a restroom. Also requires contractors to provide menstruation supplies on the jobsite, as well as sanitary conditions and refrigeration for lactation. Other provisions. Sent to the Governor on June 29th.

SB 4025 (R. Villivalam) Amends the Environmental Protection Act. The owner of a private property must allow the community water supply access to the property to replace, on the private side of the property, the lead service line or the galvanized requiring replacement service line if the community water supply is offering such a replacement at no cost to the property owner. If the owner of the private property is unavailable or unwilling to provide consent, any legal occupant of the private property may provide consent for access to the community water supply or the community water supply's contractor. Sent to the Governor on June 26th and signed into law on July 10th.

Contracting/Business Bills:

SB 3645 (M. Porfirio) Extends the repeal of the Design/Build Act to 1/1/30 and the Progressive Design/Build Pilot Program to 1/1/28. Signed by the Governor on June 26 to become Public Act 104-0532.

Proposed items that did not pass:

Workforce Extreme Temperature Act.

Paid Leave for All – To include construction.

New Home Buyer Protection – 2-year warranty on plumbing, hvac, and electrical.

Labor Omnibus (SB 3393) Included PWA applying to material deliveries, etc.

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MANDATORY SEXUAL HARASSMENT PREVENTION TRAINING

Public Act 101-0221 (commonly referred to as the Workplace Transparency Act), requires Illinois employers to provide sexual harassment prevention training to their employees on an annual basis, regardless of the size of the company.

Under this law, Illinois employers have until December 31st each year to train employees on sexual harassment prevention. The Act provides minimum standards that must be included in the training. To assist your business in complying with this law, the Illinois Department of Human Rights has posted the following information on its website:

- A FAQ for Sexual Harassment Prevention Training
- Minimum Sexual Harassment Prevention Training Standards for All Employers

Employers must either develop their own sexual harassment prevention training program that equals or exceeds the minimum standards for sexual harassment prevention training outlined in Section 2-109(B) of the Illinois Human Rights Act, or they may use the model training provided by the IDHR. Louisiana's HB953: A Warning Sign for the Trades

On June 12, 2026, Governor Jeff Landry signed **HB953** into law — and with it, Louisiana enacted what PHCC believes to be the most damaging rollback of plumbing licensure standards seen anywhere in the country in recent memory. For context: in 2019, the Texas Legislature nearly allowed its state plumbing licensing board to sunset entirely before Governor Greg Abbott intervened to preserve it. HB953 doesn't go that far, but in some ways, what it does is more consequential.

The law does not eliminate plumbing licensure, but it dismantles the independent governance structure that has made Louisiana's plumbing licensing framework effective. The State Plumbing Board of Louisiana — until now the only building trade in the state with its own independent regulatory authority — is being folded into the Louisiana State Licensing Board of Contractors as a subcommittee, with the Board of Contractors assuming ultimate authority over license issuance. Decisions that were once made by subject matter experts and experienced plumbing professionals will now be made by a body without that specialized expertise.

The most consequential provision, however, involves hours requirements. Beginning Jan. 1, 2027, apprentices will need only 2,500 hours to sit for the journeyman's exam, and journeymen will need only 1,000 hours of work experience to be eligible for a contractor's license. These reductions create a compounding risk: less-prepared workers entering the market faster, at every level of the licensing pipeline.

Louisiana is not an isolated case. PHCC has been tracking a troubling pattern across the country as states and localities pursue the weakening of building trade licensing requirements, building code freezes, and broad reciprocity agreements — all under the banner of housing affordability. California has seen residential code freezes. North Carolina is weighing a proposal for unlimited licensing reciprocity with no evaluation of whether other states maintain comparable standards. What was once a largely partisan policy posture is now drawing bipartisan support, because the affordability argument is politically appealing — regardless of what it actually costs in building safety, workforce quality, and long-term resilience.

The problem with that logic is straightforward: cutting corners doesn't lower costs, it defers them. Work done by undertrained hands creates failures that must be repaired — and those repairs cost far more than the savings ever justified. More fundamentally, the plumbing and HVAC trades aren't an abstraction. They are the systems that deliver clean water, maintain indoor air quality, and protect the health and safety of every building occupant. The public risk of weakening the standards that govern this work is real and serious.

PHCC urges our state and local chapters and industry partners to take this moment seriously. Engage your elected officials proactively. Make the case for a well-trained workforce and a rigorous licensing framework — not as a matter of professional self-interest, but as a matter of public health and safety. And know that PHCC stands ready to support you in that work. PHCC will be rolling out a new webpage of resources and stories that can be used to help make these arguments in state capitals across the country. 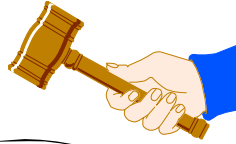

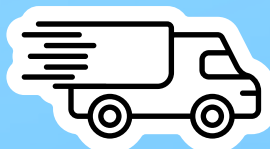
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
